Our church planting teams have continued to work hard by phone, texting, and online services. We are grateful to the Lord Jesus that in the last quarter — "COVID Quarter" — we still saw 29 new churches established among unreached people groups. These new churches give us a total of 251 churches toward Mission Impact, our goal to plant 4,000 brand new churches by the year 2024.




